

Hat Jack

Using your Hat Jack

To care for your headwear, including panama, straw, felt, tweed caps and hats. A Hat Jack will:-

Prolong the usage and maintain a good and comfortable fit.

Prevent a wet hat or cap from shrinking.

Maintain the comfort and fit.

Ease and increase the size.

Storage instructions

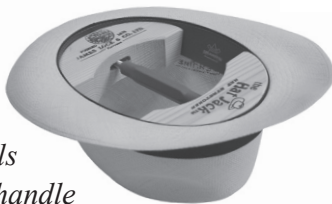
Labels uppermost (the wooden parts are tapered).

Turn the handle to approximately the size of your hat.

Place in the hat labels up, central handle aligned front to back.

Turn handle until it is a snug fit.

Store a hat resting on the crown with brim uppermost.



Increase size

(follow the storage instructions)

Then fill a kettle or pan with water, place the lid ajar and boil.

Until a steady jet of steam appears.

Hold Hat Jack handle, position the hat over the steam.



Ensure that the steam is only played on the outside band area of the hat.

Twist handle, apply more steam.

Leave Hat Jack in the hat until cool.

Repeat if hat needs further adjustment.
